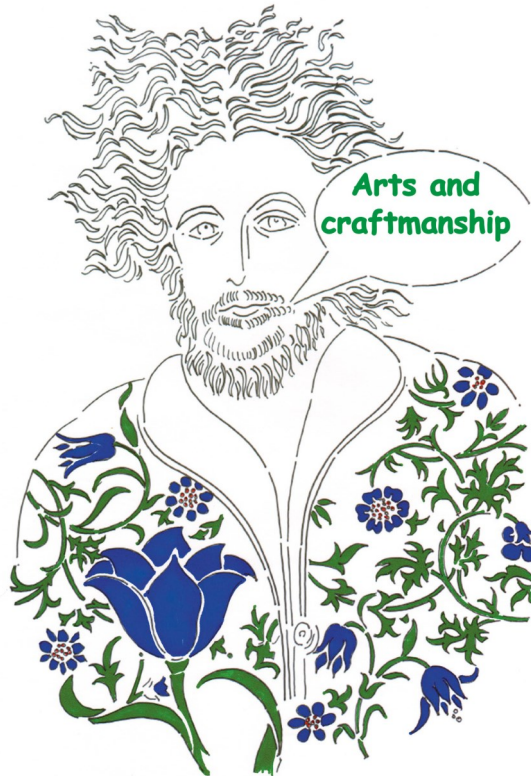

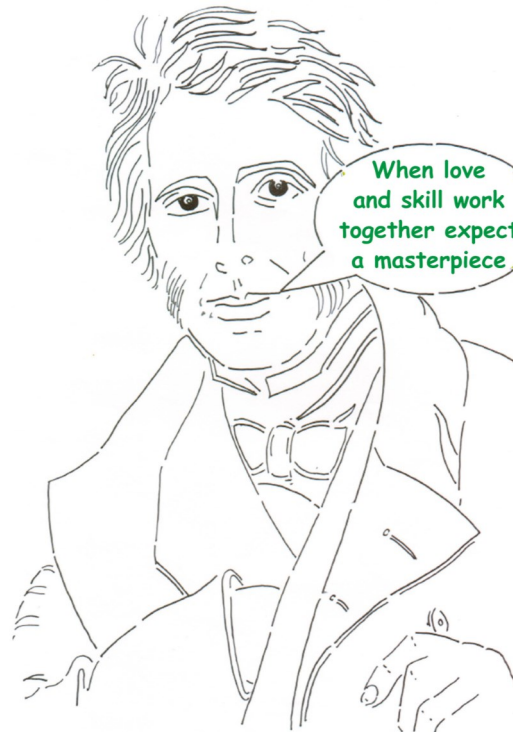


William Morris Kelmscott Manor

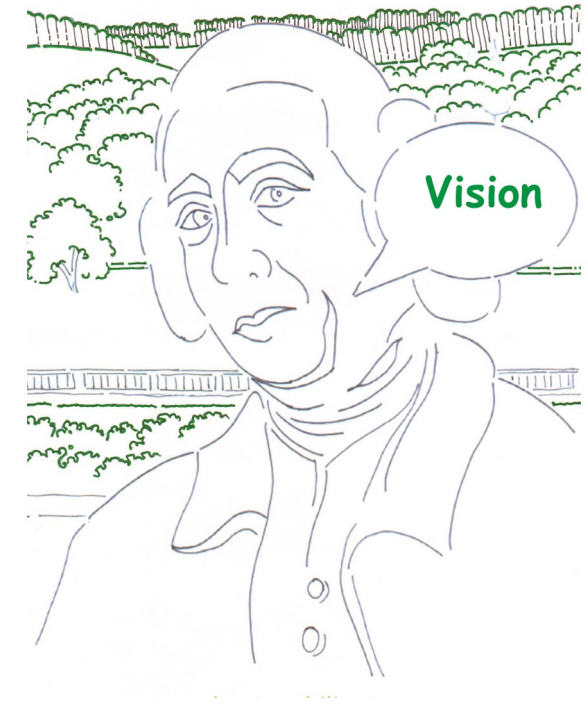


John Ruskin Christchurch Oxford

Sir Winston Leonard Spencer-Churchill

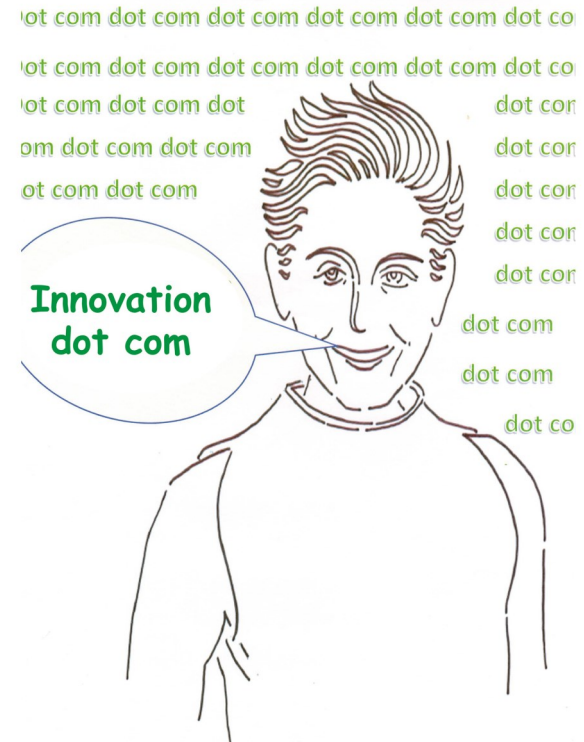
Born at Blenheim Palace and buried at Bladon.
